**High School Bank Branch Enrichment:** Clinton Savings Bank is a local community sponsor partner for **Banzai**, offering no-cost financial literacy courses to students and supporting their future financial security. CSB is covering costs for use of Banzai (the online software, resource library, and printed booklets) at Clinton Middle School; West Boylston Middle High School; Tahanto Regional Middle/High School; Oak Middle School; and Nashoba Regional High School.

**Jeans Day Fundraiser for YWCA Central Massachusetts:** Clinton Savings Bank has set a fundraising goal for the [YWCA Central Massachusetts](#), where the Bank will match funds raised by employees who donate to wear jeans for a day.
