The Diaper-A-Day Diaper Pantry provides 30 diapers a month for children, newborn up to 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ years old, living in Clinton, Bolton, Sterling, Lancaster, Berlin or Boylston. It is open on the first Wednesday of each month from 4-5:30 pm and on the third Tuesday of each month from 10:30 am – 12 pm. More than 1,000 diapers are given to area families each month. The Church of the Good Shepherd and the Presbyterian Church, also in Clinton, and the First Congregational Church in Boylston are the sponsors of the diaper pantry.
